## TINTO JOVEN

A fresh, vibrant, and easy-drinking young wine with intense red fruit aromas. The palate shows an excellent balance between acidity and freshness, with round, fine, and persistent tannins.

### HARVEST AND WINEMAKING

Produced using grapes from our own vineyards. Harvested manually, plot by plot, at optimal ripeness. Alcoholic and malolactic fermentations are carried out in stainless steel tanks. The wine is then clarified and stabilized prior to bottling.

### TASTING NOTES

**Appearance:** Clean and bright, with purple to violet-red hues, medium intensity, and a purplish rim.

**Nose:** Intense and fresh red fruit aromas with notes of wild berries.

**Palate:** Light and pleasant, with lively tannins, good balance between acidity and freshness, and medium persistence.
